Website Cookies

Hotjar

Google Analytics

Only anonymised information is exchanged with this party about the use of the website. Google Analytics prohibits sending personally identifiable information to Google Analytics. In addition we hide parts of the IP address (IP masking) to apply additional anonymisation.

Social cookies - 'Cookies that allow functionality from social media networks.'

To allow functionality from social media networks such as LinkedIn, third party cookies are used on the SixtyLearn.com. We have no control over these third-party cookies. LinkedIn

The LinkedIn Insight Tag enables the collection of metadata such as IP address information, timestamp, and events (e.g. page views). All data is encrypted.

The LinkedIn browser cookie is stored in a user's browser until a user deletes the cookie or the cookie expires (there's a rolling six-month expiration from the last time the user's browser loaded the Insight Tag). Users have full control to block or delete cookies.

Stores data relating to the current user. Essential as it keeps the user logged in between pages.

XSRF-TOKEN

Used to prevent cross site request forgery attacks - <https://owasp.org/www-community/attacks/csrf>

Dynamic

This cookie will have a dynamic name which will change for each login. For example - Dr3VezauNDEusAb4hDgXwZKMEUbEVesL7LKqP6yu. Used for security purposes.

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Mouseflow

On all app.sixtylearn.com domains we use Mouseflow: a website analytics tool that provides session replay, heatmaps, funnels, form analytics, feedback surveys, and similar features/functionality. Mouseflow may record your clicks, mouse movements, scrolling, form fills (keystrokes) in non-excluded fields, pages visited and content, time on site, browser, operating system, device type (desktop/tablet/phone), screen resolution, visitor type (first time/returning), referrer, anonymized IP address, location (city/country), language, and similar meta data. Mouseflow does not collect any information on pages where it is not installed, nor does it track or collect information outside your web browser.
